1. Northfields and Humphreys Farm

Humphreys land. Although we live on the Hewlett Close development I'm sure with sight there could be more housing made available.

The field opposite Northfields, sloping down to Church Lane.

Land behind Hewlett Close

There is room for more at Humphreys. Nowhere else please.

Hewlett Close Segon Farm North side Hazely Road

Humphreys Old Farm and annex

The existing expansion at Northfields seems ideal for continuation of affordable/social housing.

Northfields Farm

There is still some land around Hewlett Close.

The only site I can think of, is the site at Humphreys Farm where there are already affordable houses.

Land at back of Hewlett Close, Northfields

The site at Northfields has plenty of room for a good community to be made.

Grassland/meadow close to Humphrey Farms.

Further development of Northfields? Any space around the small industrial estate

Not Northfields

No, but preference is to spread it out and don't put more at Northfields.

Not Northfields - too far from centre of village and services such as school, shop and post office.

2.Social club

3.Fields near the surgery

The field adjacent to the surgery car park.

Wickhams and near surgery -field behind Roman Road & off Hazley Road

Northfields area and beyond "Manor Farm Green"

Haven't looked, but Northfields is seemingly the only place anyone is happy to build on. Too many Nimbys in the village probably.

(This -being a small development of affordable housing) Yes -Hazeley Road, adjoin at village hall/surgery car park. Twyford Social Club.

Unsure. Many of the roads are very narrow and access difficult so location is vital. Beyond the surgery in Hazeley Road

4.Churchfields

Small fields between church fields and the church next to the foot path.

Below Love Lane & opposite the prep school -next to the Watson's House?
Yes -knock down Twyford Social Club (it is an eyesore) and build modest housing on the site.

Grassland/meadow below the church.

David Wickham field adjoining the parish hall car park.

"Wickham's Field" above the surgery backing on to the pre-prep of Twyford school

Field behind Twyford surgery or Northfields or field above Churchfields Rd and areas of the Humphreys feedmill redevelopment also being viable - I do not think the village should expand along the roadways or build along the river

5.Other sites

I offered activity supports for just such a scheme 10 years ago and was refuse. Infill between the village and Colden Common would make the most infrastructure sense.

None -infrastructure (particularly) drainage is causing problems to those in low lying areas.

Otterbourne Road houses have sold off parts of their garden to build houses.

Everywhere around Twyford I see sites.

The single storey redundant police office and garages -ideal as it is close to all amenities.

I am not in a position to know of any particular area but would advise a brown field site on the outskirts of Twyford with a possible bus route.

Land within Curtilage of Down End, Bourne Lane subject is access issues. Field on South side of Hazeley Road to west of Littlebourne.

Not the common/meadow.

I don't know what land is available for sale and if available would be appropriate. I am sceptical about the power and will of the planners to work for the good of the village due to years of lost battles over Humphreys.

Brown sites should be used

Land next to parish hall, land opposite parish hall. Manor Farm Green

Twyford/Otterbourne
